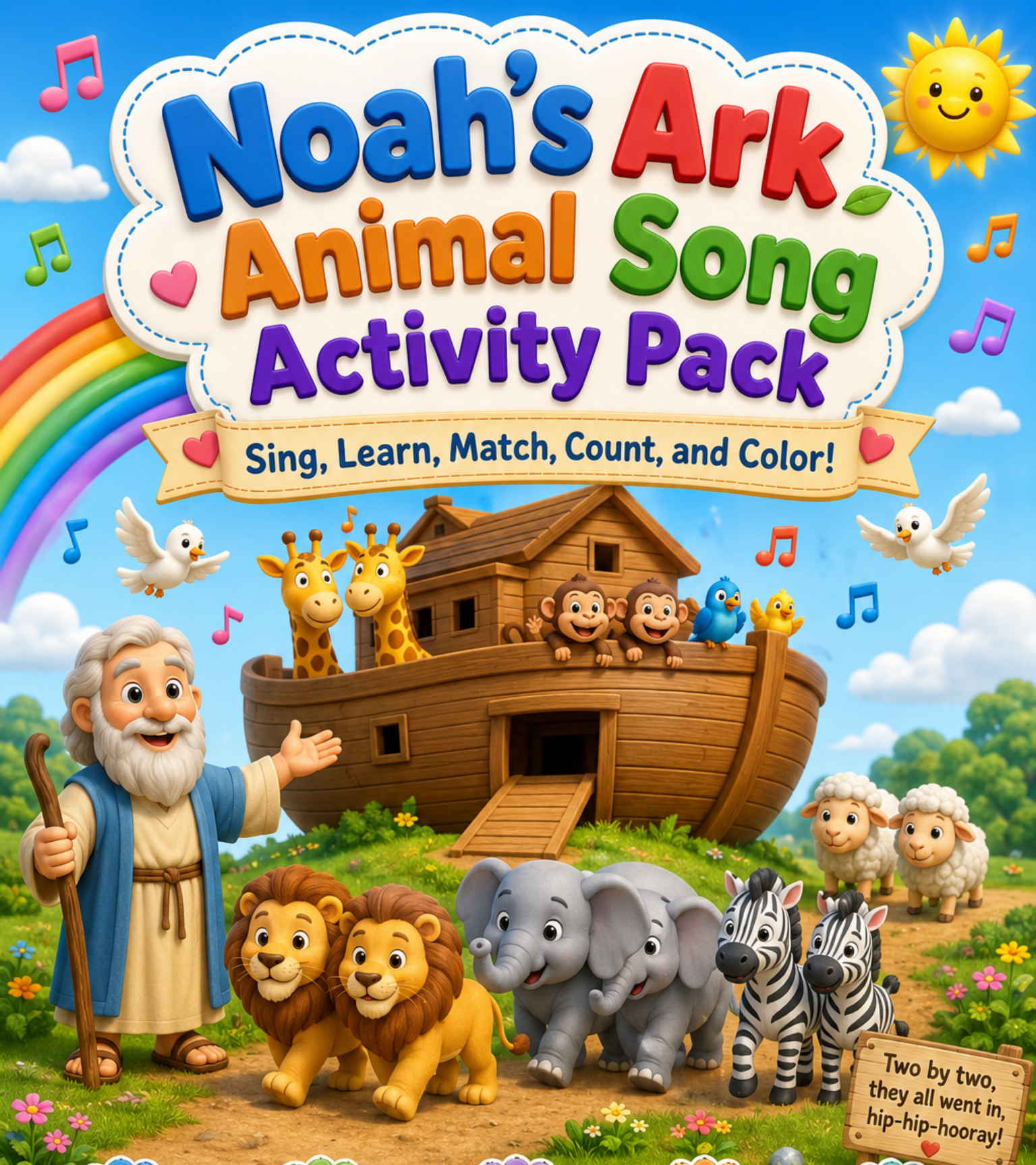

How to Use This Pack

Simple Bible story learning through songs, animals, counting, and play

1 Sing

Start with the Noah's Ark song or one animal sound verse.

2 Move

Let children stomp, flap, roar, waddle, or march two by two.

3 Make

Color, match, count, build, or draw as you talk about the story.

4 Remember

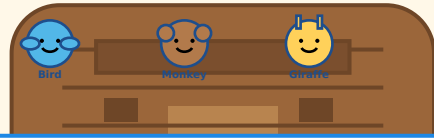
End with a rainbow promise, a kind thought, or a short prayer.

Adult note

Always supervise children during crafts, movement games, small pieces, scissors, glue, crayons, and toy play. Keep the focus on joy, safety, and connection.

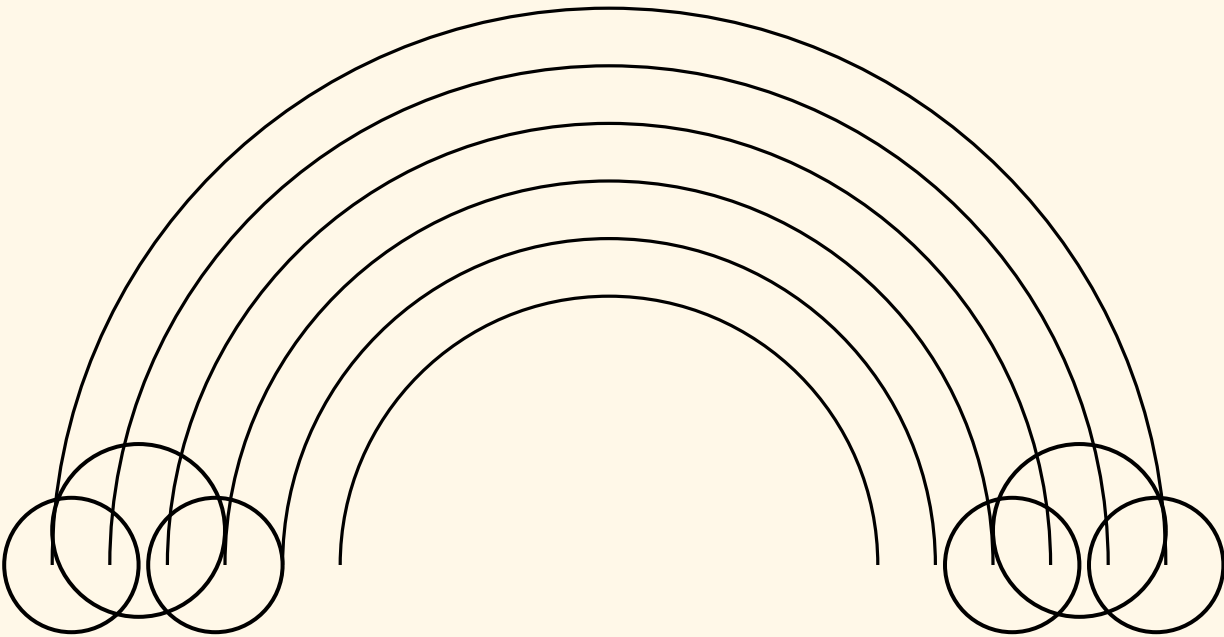

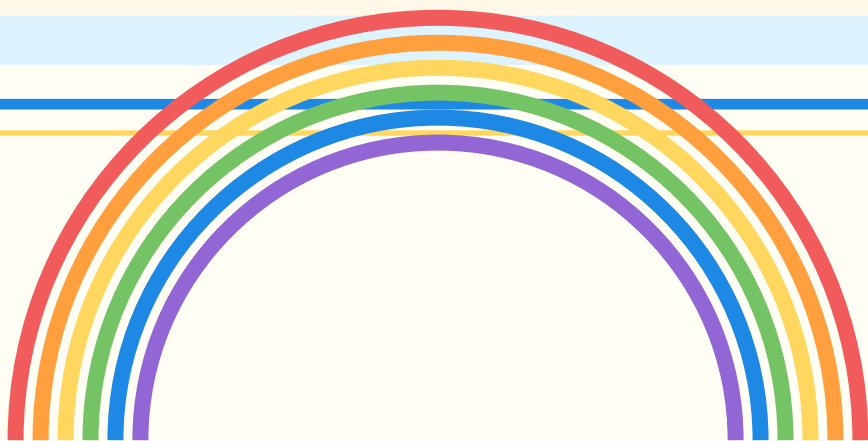
